

STATEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Bournemouth Airport acknowledges its duty to protect the environment and we are committed to minimising the environmental impact of our operations.

We are committed to continually improving our environmental performance, preventing pollution, protecting the environment and complying with all environmental legislation and other requirements.

In order to achieve this, we will:

- 1. Demonstrate strong leadership and governance through our Risk Management Process. We will consider environmental protection in our operational and investment decision making, taking into account how the environment affects our operation.
- 2. Ensure environmental considerations are embedded in decision making across all Airport business processes.
- 3. Communicate our policy to all people working for, or on behalf of, Bournemouth Airport and make it available to the public.
- 4. Define, implement and maintain an environmental management system in line with the requirements of environmental legislation.
- 5. Provide information and relevant training on environmental management to compliance to employees and relevant stakeholders.
- 6. Develop and grow Bournemouth Airport in a managed and sustainable manner. We will purchase energy-efficient products and services, where possible, and consider whole life cycle impacts of the products and services.
- 7. Engage in a constructive an open dialogue with all stakeholders, including local communities and other interested parties, to deliver best practice environmental management across the Airport.
- 8. Provide adequate resources and assign clear responsibilities for environmental management in order to deliver on requirements and our commitments. We will seek to engage the combined skills and energy of all employees.
- 9. Assess the impact on the environment of all activities at the Airport and set objectives and targets to drive continual improvement of environmental performance.
- 10. Develop and implement environmental strategies and procedures to deliver on this policy.
- 11. Monitor and measure our environmental performance in a challenging and critical way. Undertake audits to ensure compliance with legislation, this policy and our systems and processes.
- 12. Review this policy and the effectiveness of our management systems as part of our management review process.

This statement of policy will remain subject to review to ensure its continued adequacy.
